VETERANS CORNER



In this part of our Newsletter we would like to acknowledge individuals for their service and their endless contributions to the American Legion Mason Dixon Post 194. This month the Mason Dixon Post 194 proudly salute Neil Eller.

Neil was drafted in April of 1967. He was inducted at Fort Holabird, MD. He was sent to Fort Bragg, NC for his eight week basic training. While at Fort Bragg he was given a chance to audition for the 82nd Airborne Division Band. Neil passed his audition and was selected to become a member of the 434th U.S. Army Band, stationed at FT. Gordon, GA. The 434th Army Band was kept very busy providing music to various Military Schools stationed at FT. Gordon and throughout the states of GA., SC., and NC. In November 1967 Neil was selected to play in the NATO band in Brussels, Belgium. However, before he could go to Brussels the orders were cancelled so Neil stayed at FT. Gordon until April 1969 when he was released from the service. Neil has been a member of the American Legion Mason Dixon Post 194 for 54 years. Neil has held numerous officer positions at the Mason Dixon Post 194, including Commander for 10 years, 1st Vice Commander for numerous years, and 3rd Vice Commander. Neil is the chairperson of the Executive committee and the Slot Machine committee. Neil has been in charge of several different programs that are essential to keeping Post 194 running. Neil has been and still is a central part of the Mason Dixon Post 194.
